### ANNUAL COOKIE PACK



The *Virginia Beach Correctional Center* would not take home baked items at this time so we converted our efforts. As of last year, Thrivent Financial was contacted and the following congregations were able to receive \$250 grants for the project: Emmanuel, Prince of Peace, St. John, St. Timothy and Our Saviour. A private donation of \$200 came from Christ Lutheran also. With that money a number of snack items were bought for the 1300 prisoners as well as a number of stamps that helped them send holiday greetings to their families.
