My Dear Family in Christ,

As we well know, two of the most iconic texts in the Bible, Genesis 1 and John 1 begin with "In the beginning.....". The Genesis verse goes on to relate the beginning of the natural or physical world as we know and experience it.

The verse from John relates the beginning of spiritual creation or "new birth". But even this is grounded in a physical event, the Word (Jesus the Christ) becoming flesh and dwelling, literally "pitching his tent among us", an analogy to the Tabernacle (abode of the living God) in the center of the encampment of Israelites as they trod through the wilderness.

Well, we now stand at the beginning of a new civil year of 2021 (the church year began November 29, 2020, the first Sunday of Advent). Our month January is derived from the two-faced ROMAN god Janus, depicted with the profiles of two faces, one looking forward and the other looking backwards.


