### The Lutheran Women of Tidewater **Cookie Pack**

The Women's groups from St. Timothy, Our Saviour, Emmanuel and St. John again continued to provide cookies for the 1500 inmates at the Virginia Beach Correctional Center. Because of the pandemic, the jail will not accept home baked cookies. Therefore for the last few years we have had to buy them. This year the cookies were one of the items in a ditty bag to be given to each inmate. We have been able to get \$250 grants from Thrivent (a financial services organization founded by Lutherans). Each congregation has members who have policies with Thrivent. These members can apply for the Community Service Grants. The cookies already purchased had been delivered to the Chaplain at the facility. So two \$250 grants requested by St. John members were used for postage stamps to be used on Christmas cards provided for prisoners to send greetings to friends and relatives. It is good to be associated with other church and to provide for those who might be forgotten.
